Parking Around the School

Please ensure that you are following the parking signage around the school.

- **Castella Street**- There is an area near the crossing outside the church where no parking is allowed. The signage is not clear for this but please be aware that parking is not allowed in this area. I will put some cones out today so that you can see where you are not allowed to park
- **Castella Street outside the Court House**- Please be aware that there are two spots that it is a two hour parking window only
- **Clarke street - opposite the paddock**- please ensure that your car or vehicle is not blocking the pathway as we have some disabled residents who have not been able to use this path and have had to go onto the road.
- **Jones Street**- Please remember that on the school side between 8am and 9am this is a five-minute drop off area and the rest of the day only one hour parking.



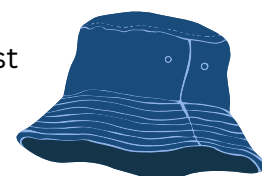
SEIL Change

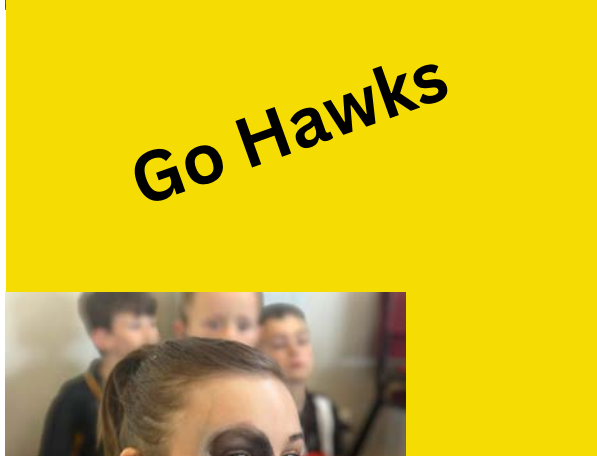
