Please note, we have had headlice reported amongst numerous children today. Please check your children's hair regularly.

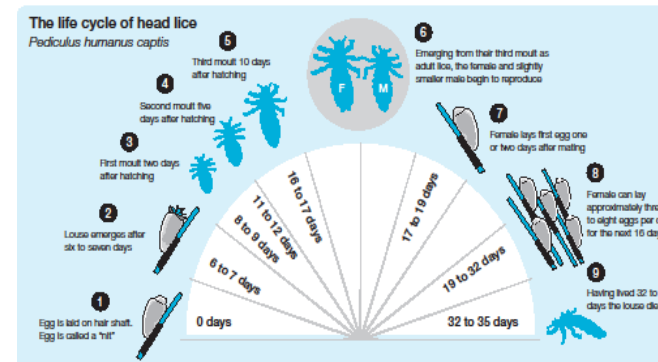
If you should discover eggs or nits you can obtain lotions, combs, etc. from your family chemist. Our Yarra Ranges Shire Council can also assist.

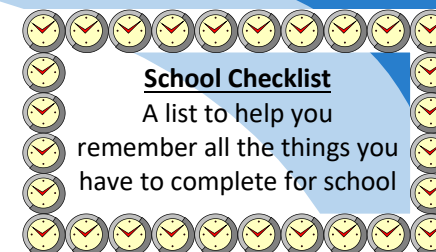
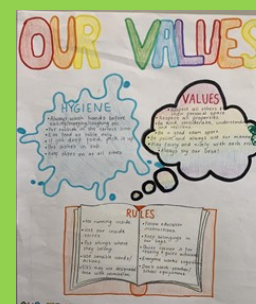
What's Been Happening?
