We have in our office area details of the Swinburne Psychology Clinic - One step at a Time Program which helps Parents with students who are suffering from anxiety. This could be for a range of issues that your child may be experiencing including:

- Difficulties sleeping at night due to worries
- Fears and phobias
- Difficulty separating from you or worrying about parental safety
- Trouble sleeping alone in their bed
- Fear of the dark
- Scared of lifts, trains, and people
- Fear of dogs and other animals
- Excessive worry and constant reassurance seeking
- Fear of germs and other health problems

We have run 6,181km and are now only 443km from Broome.




