



#### Red Slide Climbing Frame Renovations and Working Bee 7th December from 2.15pm

## What's Been Happening

Two of our school captains,

the Remembrance Day
Service at the Lilydale
Cenotaph at 11am on
Saturday 11th November.
They both shared reading a
poem and respectfully laid
the Lilydale PS wreath at the
base of the memorial.



Our Grade 5/6s are building billy carts. They have all attached the struts to the chassis and attached the rope. On Friday they attached their axles and wheels if they had them. This week we will be working on their chairs.



The Grade 5/6 students were invited to the Lilydale RSL on Thursday 9th November. Here, they listened to two incredible war heroes speak about their time in the Vietnam War between 1968-1970. Mr Bill Dobson (far right - see photo below) and Mr John O'Donahue (middle) both served 2 years in their early 20s. Anthony McAleer, a local historian, shared the history and stories of men who served in the area and the nurses from the Alfred Hospital who volunteered to serve in Vietnam.

Anthony shared a story of Ernest Pearson who joined the Army at 15 and served as the bugler and messenger on the front lines. He was awarded the military medal and lost his bugle when under fire. This bugle was later recovered and 2 generations on, was passed on to the Mount Evelyn RSL. The kids were able to see this bugle and the engravings that lead to finding its owner.

We also heard from Chris Newell, who served in the Royal Navy.

The kids listened attentively and showed a high level of respect to these men who served our country.
