If your child is unwell

Just a reminder that if your child is ill or is feeling unwell, they must not attend school. They must remain home and seek medical advice. This includes coughs and colds. Reports

At the moment the teaching staff are working on the Semester One Reports and as you are aware these reports will look different from previous versions. They will include:

- a description of the areas of the Victorian Curriculum F-10 taught
- a succinct descriptive assessment of student learning achievement, based on the Achievement Standards in the Victorian Curriculum F-10
- a comment on how the student has adjusted to the remote and flexible learning environment, with reference to the Personal and Social Capability curriculum.

Prep Transition Dates and Sessions

The date for Prep Enrolments for 2021 has changed to Friday 7th August. This will give prospective parents the chance to tour schools early in Term 3. As yet there is no starting date for the Pathway to Prep due to the ongoing COVID 19 Pandemic. We will be waiting for the Department to issue further clarification relating to transition sessions and let you know as soon as possible.

Drop off and Pick Up

Thank you to everyone for their efforts in picking up your students from school, this has made the whole process very smooth. Just a reminder to arrive at the time you have been allocated rather than arriving too early to ensure we have enough parking spots for everyone allocated at that time. Please try to leave the area as quick as you can to ensure others are not waiting for a spot and there are not congregations of adults at the entrances.

Breakfast Club

As you may be aware our relationship with Victoria Foodbank has allowed us to offer a wide range of fruit, cereal, toast, fruit cups and drinks which the students are enjoying. At the moment we are staffing the Breakfast Club using the School Staff however when the restrictions finally ease we will be looking for volunteers to help us continue to run this for our students five days a week. If you are interested in helping out please let us know so that we can organise this efficiently when we start getting back to normal.
