School Council Elections

All information relating to our School Council elections will be advertised in the coming newsletters. For families new to the school, the School Council is presently made up of 8 parent members and 4 staff members. Each year, half of the positions are declared vacant, and all parents are eligible to stand for election.

School Council meets monthly (eight meetings per year) and plays an important role in determining school policy and discussing key matters relating to the school.

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Elite Sports Students to try out for VIC State Team

At various times throughout the school year, School Sport Victoria (District, Division, Region and State levels) communicates with schools about opportunities for elite sport students to be nominated to participate in competitions or state team trials. If your child did not bring home an application letter and fits the criteria listed, please see Mrs Matthews to get an application form.

If your child is competing/performing at an elite level, your child will have the opportunity to participate in their respective sport, within the school sport program. The targeted sports include: AFL, Cricket, Netball, Basketball, Tennis, Swimming, Diving, Athletics, Cross Country, Rugby League, Golf, Soccer, Softball/T-Ball, Hockey, Volleyball + others.

If your child fits within all three criteria points outlined below, and you are interested in them potentially taking part in an SSV event or trial, (if an opportunity arises throughout the year) please see Mrs Matthews to complete the required form by Friday 13th February, 2026

CRITERIA

- Child is in Year 3*, 4, 5 or 6 in 2026
- Child participates in a sport at an 'ELITE' level outside of school. (i.e. Rep Basketball/Netball in the top teams, Squad Swimming, AFL/Soccer Most Valuable Player Winner)
- Child demonstrates an acceptable level of behaviour within the school environment.


