Dear Parent/Guardians,

Please find below details of the Parent payment arrangements that we have put in place for 2021. When constructing this payment plan we considered the incredible impact that the COVID19 pandemic has had on our community. Many families are suffering financial hardship and therefore we intend to reduce the parent payments down from \$110 to \$72 (the details can be found on the following page.) We are also aware that some consumables have not been used in 2020 due to remote learning and this has supported the reduction in our costs. The costs we will be charging for 2021 have been thought about very carefully and will be essential for the smooth running of our school. We hope that this reduction will help support you during this difficult time and that you will talk to the School Office should you need to make arrangements to pay this amount over the year.

We are looking forward to 2021 when hopefully we will be able to move to more normal School operations. Lilydale Primary School is very proud of the quality programs that we have put in place to cater for the needs and interests of our students. On an annual basis School Council prepares a budget to provide resources for educational programs, administration, facilities development and maintenance.

The payments listed are the minimum amount considered essential to enable School Council to continue providing the high quality standards that we have come to expect at Lilydale Primary School. Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that their children are provided with essential education items.

Parents/guardians also have the option of providing essential education items themselves. If parents and guardians choose to provide equivalent materials, this will be done in consultation with the school, as items are required to meet the specifications provided by the school and ensures consistency that all students will have the same learning materials as other students. There will be certain items that due to their nature may only be provided by the school.

As some of our families are experiencing unexpected financial hardship, we have established the voluntary *LPS Family Support Fund* for 2021. When paying your levies you will now have the option to offer assistance to another family through the **contribution of \$30 towards the LPS Family Support Fund**. The funds will go towards paying for student's school levies/booklist in 2021 for families that are experiencing financial hardship. It is our intent to ensure that no student is disadvantaged.

Financial Support for Families

Lilydale Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- Camps, Sports & Excursion funding (CSEF) available to eligible parents
- State Schools Relief support available for uniforms/footwear
- Centrepay (must have valid health care/pension card)
- Local community support
- Payment plan


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PARENTS PAYMENT POLICY ONE PAGE OVERVIEW

FREE INSTRUCTION

FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.

SCHOOL PROCESSES
