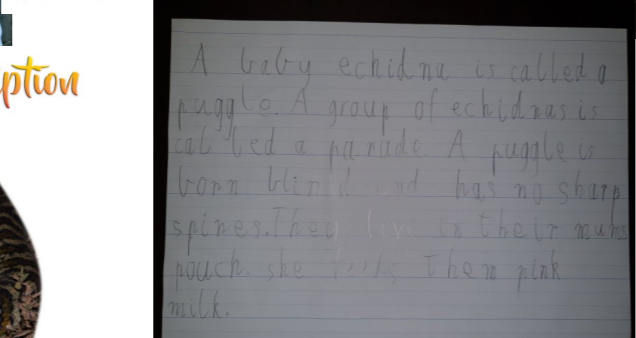


Prep News
