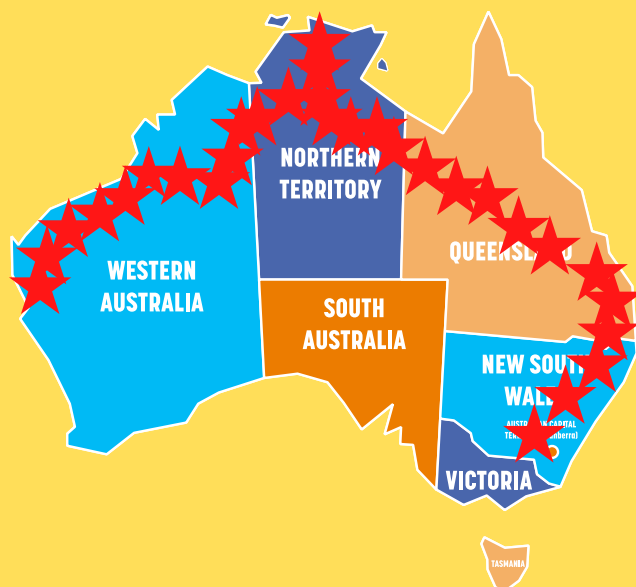




Rylan, Kai and Hudson felt like they were working in the olden days so a black and white photo was used.
