Run Around Australia Challenge




We have run 6,510km and are now only 114 km from Broome.

- Fear of the dark
- Scared of lifts, trains, and people

- Excessive worry and cons reassurance seeking
- Fear of germs and other health problems



Cost

\$20 per session/assessment. Treatment consists of seven therapy sessions plus one assessment session.
