Last Friday grade 4 students went to the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Manna Gum/Wurun Kulk conference at Mount Lilydale Mercy College.

The day involved immersing in a range of activities that teach the students about our first nations people and their culture. These included:

- A literacy/art and craft activity listening to Bunjil and then creating their own Bunjil,
- A language and tools session to learn some local Woiworung words and find out about tools and weapons,
- An art and instrument session where students made bracelets, did ochre painting, played the yidaki (didgeridoo), and tried to start a fire the traditional way,
- Marngrook- a game very similar to AFL that was played by aboriginal people using a possum skin ball (marngirk).

Students were very engaged and learnt much about our first nations culture and the Wurundjeri. We were also fed on the day with delicious recess and lunch including some native ingredients - kangaroo sausage rolls.

Thanks to the MLMC staff and students who were helpers on the day. It ran very smoothly and made for an enjoyable learning experience.
