Jones Street Drop Off and Pick Up
Please remember when you are dropping off or picking up your child on Jones Street, to drive down as far as you can. I have had a few parents concerned that this is not happening and can cause issues with other parents trying to park and having to move around the car that is pulling out. Help like this will ensure that we do not have any avoidable accidents and help keep our students safe.


Over the last few weeks, I have been on duty on Castella Street and I have noticed that certain cars are travelling way too fast in our 40 km zone.
