Curriculum Day Friday 18th August

The Curriculum Day was a great success and we managed to cover a great deal. Schoolwide Positive Behaviours was discussed and the expectations that we had of students in different parts of the School and how we can use effective language to ensure that this positive behaviour was seen. The Schoolwide Positive Behaviour team will now take this work and create a rubric that we will bring back to staff. We will then share these expectations with the students so that they fully understand what is expected of them in different areas of the school. This will ensure a consistency of approach which is what is essential when talking to students about behaviour. We then moved onto our NAPLAN Results and also talked about the changes to NAPLAN and how vital it is that we prepare students for this test as everything has changed and this will impact on student performance if we do not prepare them properly. Finally, we moved onto some team bonding which is essential as we have not met as a team for quite a while. We created some boards that where focused on adding colour to the school but also recorded the names of the animals in our local aboriginal language. Team bonding and also some nice new art for our school.

They have now drilled the footings through pure granite so this should make the wall, when it is installed, very solid indeed. 




Grade 5/6 Lune Visit


