#### **BER Wall Building Work**

Just to let you know that the demolition of the BER wall will start on the 6th March. This work has been planned to ensure that the drainage around the BER building is to a high standard. This will impact the whole school as there are areas around the school which will not be able to be accessed. Please read the details below and let me know if you have any questions.

- Work will begin on Monday 6th March with the construction of a fence around the BER Building
- Students will be able to access the BER through the Main doors, this is also the case for Extend before and after
- The fence will be 3 metres around the building.
- The pathway between the basketball court and the wall will be out of action
- We will lose 3 metres of the volleyball court
- We will lose 3 metres of the asphalt area all the way to the climbing
- The basketball court will be available as will the spider and most of the oval
- The works will last 10 weeks
- The first works will involve the removal of the trees on the western side of the BER

It is sure to be a tricky time with workmen around and access to different parts of the playground. This is vital and necessary work and I am sure if we all work together we can manage this well. I would appreciate you talking to me regularly about any issues you may encounter during the construction so that I can raise these with the builder and seek a solution.
