Grounds Keeper Job on offer

Just a reminder that Bruce has resigned and that we have a vacancy for a Grounds Keeper to complete jobs around the school. If you are interested in this role a job description can be obtained from the office by emailing Lilydale.ps@education.vic.gov.au The role includes the following responsibilities.

1. To meet with the principal every fortnight to organise the priority items that require attending to over the next fortnight
2. Maintenance jobs include but are not limited to aspects of joinery, carpentry, plumbing, repairing furniture, doors, locks, lights plant, equipment and other tasks which may arise.
3. Maintains grounds and open spaces including but not limited to gardens, lawns, ovals, including mowing, weeding, fertilizing, planting, pruning.
4. Cyclical preventative maintenance jobs as scheduled, including gutter & roof cleaning, windows, painting.
5. Follow all Health and Safety policies and procedures. Report all known and observed hazards to the Principal.
6. Participate as a team member and perform hands on set ups (events and functions).
7. Clear external drains, sweep paved areas and ensure that litter is removed from garden areas.
8. Maintain garden equipment and appropriately store garden implements and chemicals.
9. Ensure that environmental sustainability is practiced.
10. Other duties as required.

Lego Club

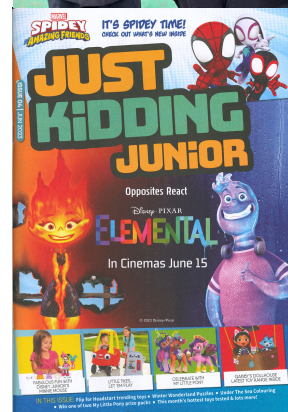

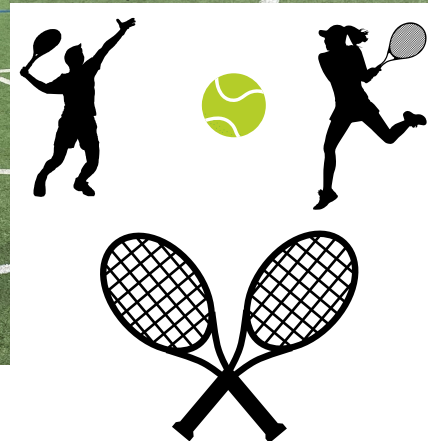

The Department of Education has released a new statewide timeline for enrolling in Foundation (Prep) for the 2024 school year. If you have a child starting primary school in 2024, it's time to enrol. Make sure to submit your enrolment application by **Friday 28 July 2023**. If you are enrolling the sibling of a student at our school for Foundation in 2024, and both children will be attending our school at the same time, your child is prioritised for a place at our school as per the department's Placement Policy. It is important to follow the statewide timeline to enrol your child in Foundation. Enrolling your child in line with the timelines allows us to plan our classrooms, staffing and transition activities and ensures your child has the best start to school.
