Dear Parents/Guardians,

At various times throughout the school year, School Sport Victoria (District, Division, Region and State levels) communicates with schools about opportunities for elite sport students to be nominated to participate in competitions or state team trials. This letter is being issued out to all students in Years 3-6 in the Mooroolbark District Sports Group as a way of ensuring that students, who are competing/performing at an elite level, do not miss a potential opportunity to participate in their respective sport, within the school sport program. The targeted sports include: AFL, Cricket, Netball, Basketball, Tennis, Swimming, Diving, Athletics, Cross Country, Rugby League, Golf, Soccer, Softball/T-Ball, Hockey, Volleyball + others.

If your child fits within all three criteria points outlined below, and you are interested in them potentially taking part in an SSV event or trial, (if an opportunity arises throughout the year) please complete the form below and return this whole notice to your School Sport Coordinator by Friday 17th February, 2023. The short turn-around time is necessary to ensure that opportunities which may arise at the start of the school year are not missed.

CRITERIA

- Child is in Year 3*, 4, 5 or 6 in 2023.
- Child participates in a sport at an 'EUTE' level outside of school. (i.e. Rep Basketball/Netball in the top teams, Squad Swimming, AFL/Soccer Most Valuable Player Winner)
- Child demonstrates an acceptable level of behaviour within the school environment.
- *There are restrictions relating to children who are turning 8 in the current year, being eligible to participate beyond the District level of competition.
- *Most SSV team trial apportunities are targeted at Year 5-6 students.

<u>If a situation arises</u> where your child's sports coordinator believes that your child should be nominated for a trial or a competition, they will contact you. **Please don't confuse this letter with an actual application or entry form, for an actual trial or event**. The letter/form serves a similar purpose as a survey does, i.e. to gather information. Your school sports coordinator will retain the returned forms.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- · \$125 for primary school students
- · \$225 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
