Yarning Conference.

Last week 4E was invited to attend the inaugural Yarning Conference at Mount Lilydale Mercy College. We took part in a range of activities. We learnt about Wirundjeri language and culture including instruments and tools. Another activity was trading the Dreaming story about Bunjil the eagle- the creator- and drew our own illustrations. We learned about the origin of AFL - Marngrook- and how it was played with a possum skin ball. Our class created a banner for our school which was a tree decorated with wooden leaves that we illustrated with things that are special and meaningful to us.

There was also some delicious food made from native ingredients for us to try.

We all learned the real meaning of Wominjeka, which means 'come with a purpose'. We also learned where the word Wurundjeri comes from. 'Wurun' = Manna gum, and 'djeri' = grub that lives and eats the bark of the Manna gum.

Mrs Inglese, Mr Ellis and the students all learned a lot and had a great day.


