Three Way Conferences

Just a reminder to please ensure you use Sentral to book in your Three Way conference time. These conferences are a chance for you to meet with your child and their teacher to discuss the work your child has completed in their Semester One portfolio, their achievements, and their challenges. You will also work together to understand the next stage of your child's learning and discuss your child's learning goals for Semester 2. This year, the conferences will last for ten minutes. These interviews are scheduled for during the school day due to the new Victorian Schools Agreement that would require us to provide Time in Lieu should teachers go over their set hours. This would be untenable for the school to afford. If you are unable to meet on the day of the meeting or require extra time with the class teacher please contact them to arrange an alternative time or date. Three-way conferences are an important part of the partnership between home, school and the student. By working together, we can provide the best opportunities for our students to learn and grow as individuals.



Naplan Results

This week we have received the NAPLAN results which are presented in an entirely new format this year. NAPLAN will continue to measure student achievement in numeracy, reading, writing, spelling, and grammar and punctuation but the results will now be presented in 4 proficiency levels: These are, exceeding, strong, developing and needs additional support. This change will give schools, parents and carers clearer information that details student achievement against new proficiency levels. Students' NAPLAN reports will continue to show how they are tracking against their peers and provide an indication of their skill levels against national averages and where we would expect them to be in order to get the most out of schooling. This provides valuable information to teachers about how we can continue to support your child. This year our results are particularly strong and we have been really pleased with the progress and growth that the students have made particularly in Numeracy, Writing and Reading. We will now look at this data and use it to enable us to target future areas for improvement and how we can continue to support your child to be the best learner they can be.

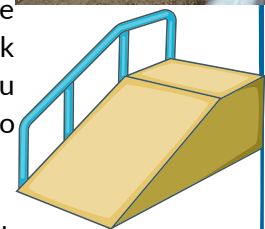
Wall Saga

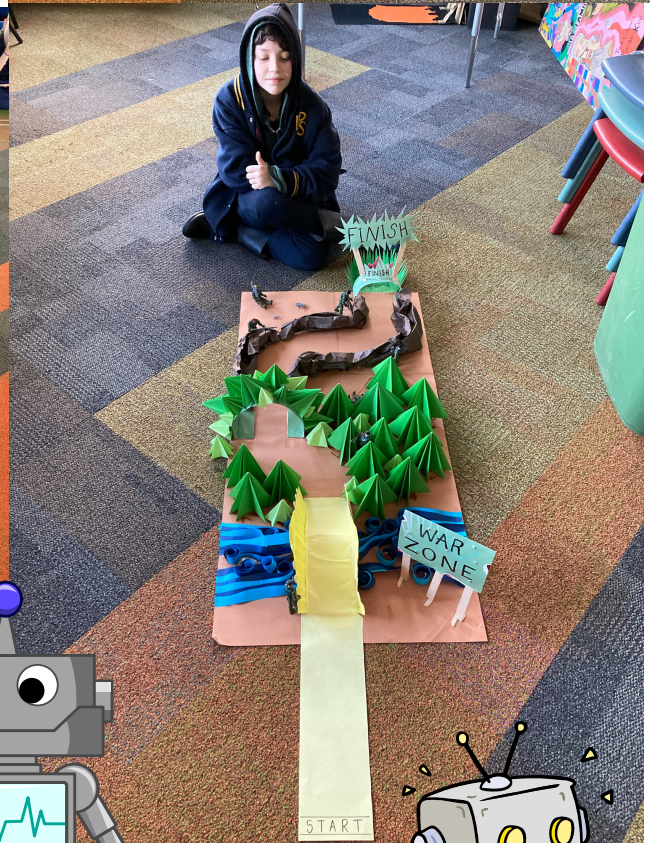
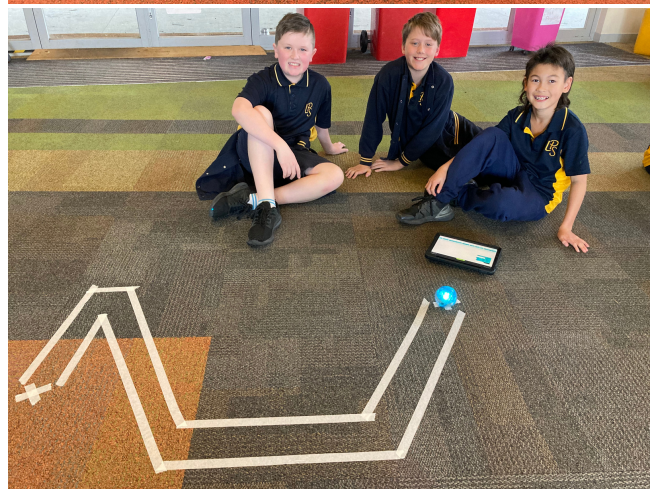
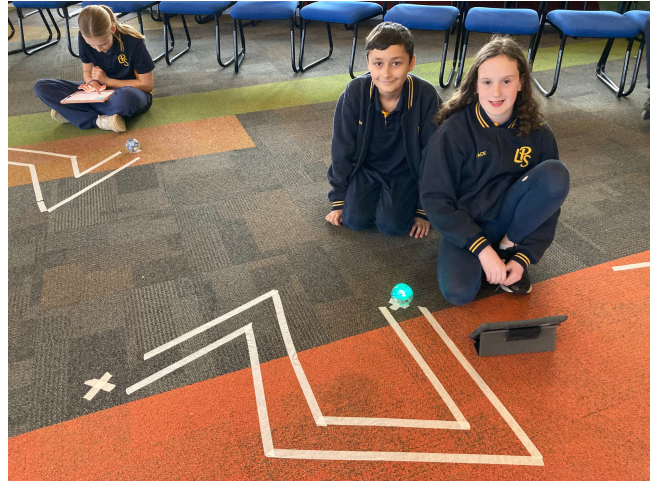
Mia can always be relied upon by staff and students alike, which makes Mia very inclusive of others, accepts their differences and makes sure those around her are happy and enjoying their time at school.

You are an extraordinary role model and friend to those around you and most deserving of the title of Aussie of the Month for June. Congratulations Mia !

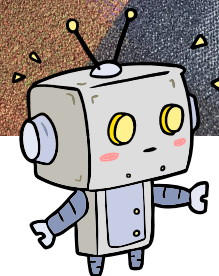
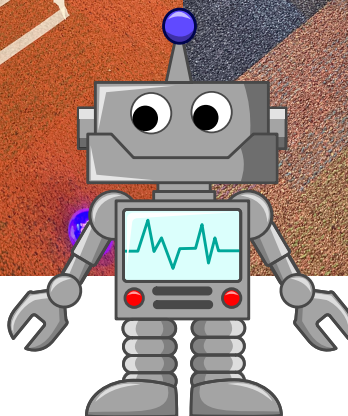
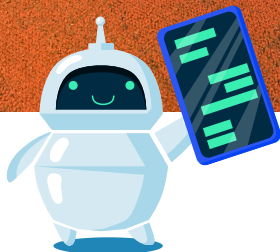
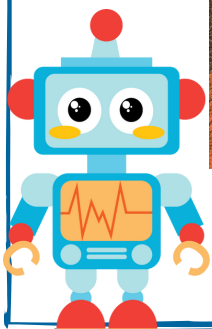
Spheros

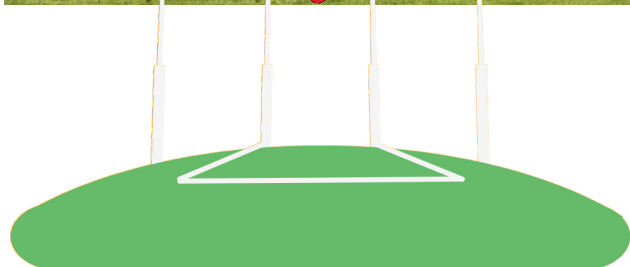

The Department of Education has released a new statewide timeline for enrolling in Foundation (Prep) for the 2024 school year. If you have a child starting primary school in 2024, it's time to enrol. Make sure to submit your enrolment application by **Friday 28 July 2023**. If you are enrolling the sibling of a student at our school for Foundation in 2024, and both children will be attending our school at the same time, your child is prioritised for a place at our school as per the department's Placement Policy. It is important to follow the statewide timeline to enrol your child in Foundation. Enrolling your child in line with the timelines allows us to plan our classrooms, staffing and transition activities and ensures your child has the best start to school. Just a reminder that the ICAS Registration closes on **Monday 31st July**. Please ensure you sign up if you wish your child to take part in this testing.

What is ICAS?

ICAS is an online academic competition that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills. Our students are able to take part in the in English, Mathematics, Science, Writing tests.

Each assessment celebrates students' accomplishments by providing opportunities for recognition and development. Every student who participates will receive a printed certificate and an online results report. Top performers will be eligible for medals.

We encourage you to consider entering your child into ICAS this year.

How to participate in ICAS

After payment is made via the Parent Payment System, you will receive an order confirmation email, please keep this for your records.

ICAS Results and Certificates

We will notify you of the date(s) that we run ICAS at the school and when your child's ICAS results are ready. Once we have received your child's ICAS certificate, we will send it home with your child. The back of the certificate shows ICAS results and the login details, "TAP ID and Pin", that you and your child need to enter the Results Portal orti.icasassessments.com/ortiStudent
