School Operation End of Term 3 and beginning of Term 4

The Victorian Government has released its plan for easing coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions. It includes the following decisions about school operations. All schools will continue to provide remote and flexible learning for the remainder of Term 3. These changes remain subject to the advice of Victoria's Chief Health Officer:

• 5th – 9th October (first week of Term 4)

Remote and flexible learning will continue for all students. On-site supervision for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students will continue to be provided consistent with existing guidelines. Please ensure that you have supplied the school with the onsite attendance form by Thursday next week.

• From 12th October

Students in Prep to Grade 2 return to full-time on-site schooling. The existing remote learning program will not continue for these year levels. Remote and flexible learning will continue for all students in Grade 3 to Grade 6, other than for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students.

• Date subject to health advice

- All students from Grade 3 to Grade 6 will continue with remote and flexible learning. A date for the return of these year levels to face-to-face learning will be subject to further health advice.
- During the staged return, outside school hours care will be available to students attending for on-site supervision and progressively for the relevant year levels returning to on-site learning.
- Vacation care may operate during the school holidays but only for students who are eligible for on-site supervision at school in Term 3.

No Screen Day - Monday 14th September

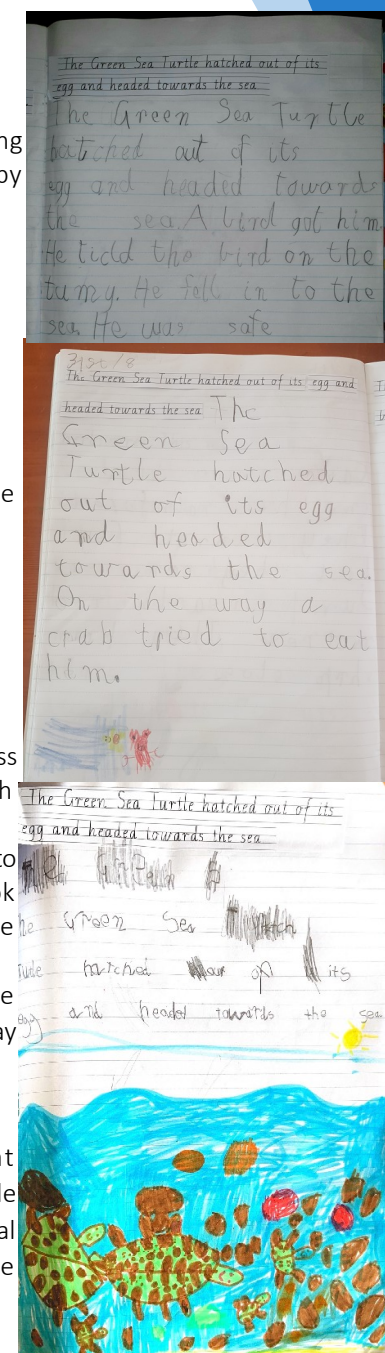
At the end of every term we organise a planning day for teachers to look at the data from their class and plan for the following term. This process ensures that we are able to match the curriculum with the learning needs of our students. In order to accommodate this planning day on Monday 14th September there will be a no Screen Day that is there will be no live WebEx sessions on this day to allow the teachers to plan for Term 4. As we are still waiting the final details of what Term 4 will look like it is important that the teachers are given this time to plan effectively. The students will still have work to complete on this day and teachers will be making this clear during the rest of this week. Students who are onsite will still be able to attend as normal and will complete the work set by the class teacher for this day. If you have any questions regarding expectations of students on this day please contact your child's class teacher.

Parent Payments for 2021

In the next few weeks, the School Council will be releasing the Parent payment arrangements that we will put in place for 2021. When constructing this payment plan we considered the incredible impact that the COVID19 pandemic has had on our community. Many families are suffering financial hardship and therefore we intend to reduce the parent payments. We are also aware that some consumables have not been used in 2020 due to remote learning and this has supported the reduction in our costs. The costs we will be charging for 2021 have been thought about very carefully and once confirmed by the School Council will be essential for the smooth running of our school. We hope that this reduction will help support you during this difficult time and that you will talk to the School Office should you need to make arrangements to pay this amount over the year.

All entries need to be submitted by

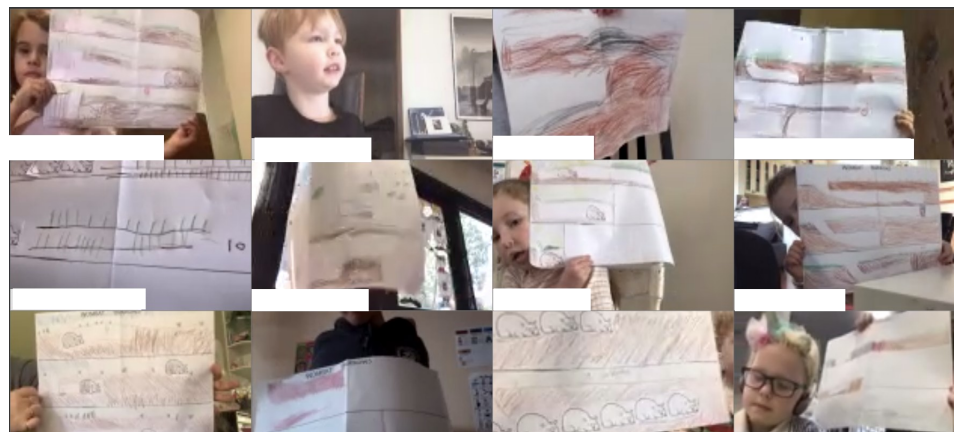
3pm on Thursday 17th September.
