Parent Educational Request Forms now available from the School Office

Parent Educational Request forms for class placement in 2024 are now available from the School Office. You are able to put in a Parent Request form until Friday 27th October. The purpose of this form is to take into account your thoughts and feelings relating to the education of your child and their placement in a new class for 2024. We want to ensure that our Grade placement is informed and reflects the best practice for consulting with parents, students and teachers. The request you make on this form should be based on the educational needs of your child and who they would work well with to improve their learning potential. You may outline any considerations that you believe we should consider when placing your child into a new class, for example, a male teacher, separation from a particular child, students your child works well with and would have a positive impact on their learning. Parents/Guardians can NOT request a particular teacher. Students will be asked to nominate five children who they would like to be placed with in the following year. They will be placed with at least one of these students as selected by the teacher, providing it is not detrimental to their learning or to the learning of other students. This process is extremely complex with lots of different considerations for the staff to take into account and as a result it may not be possible for all requests to be granted.

Reading Challenge Results

Congratulations to Prep B, 1/2S, 3/4M and 5/6M who read the most books in their Year level and have qualified for a pizza party that will take place next week to celebrate their achievements. This year we smashed the record for the most books read at our school with a whopping 9,435 books. That is an amazing achievement and beats last year's record by almost 2000 books. Next year, I hope we can read 10,000 books. A pizza party for Prep B and 1/2S will take place on Thursday 12th October and 3/4M and 5/6m will take place on Friday 13th October.




Friday 20th October 4pm - 6pm Working Bee
