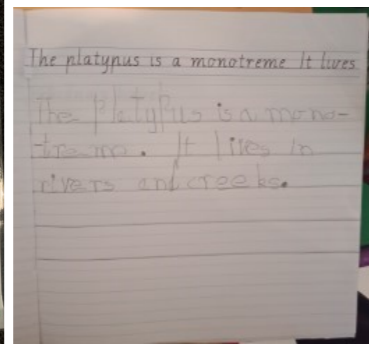
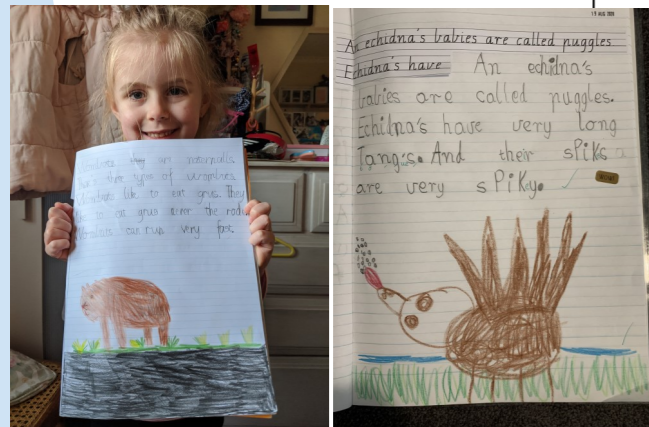


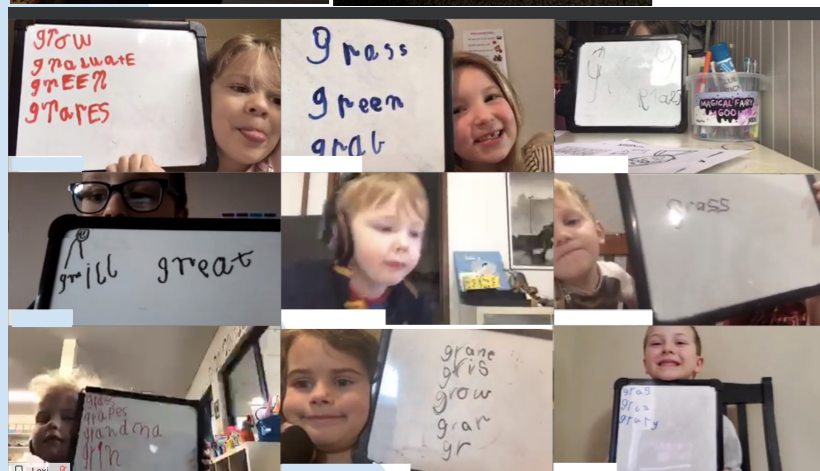
Science Week

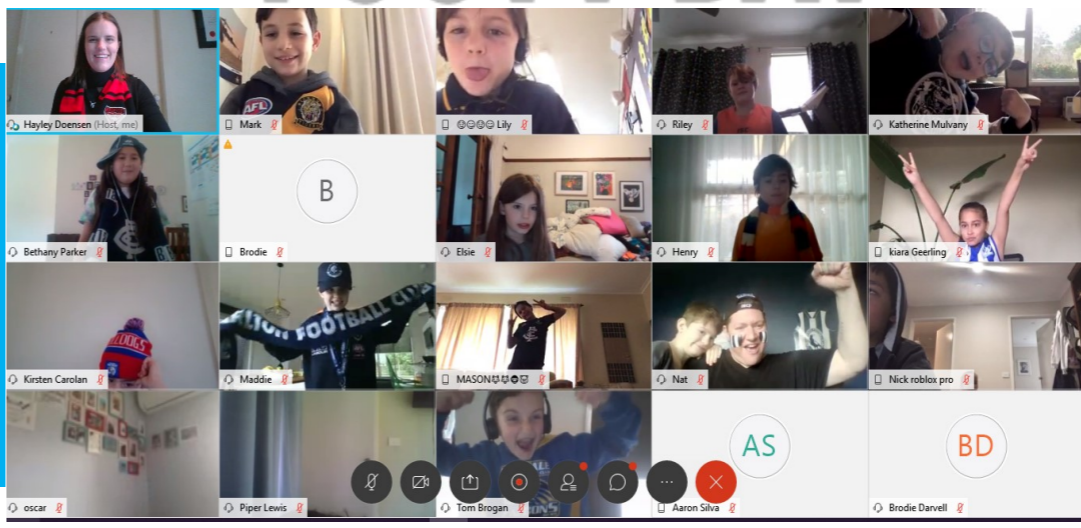
